Exporting Horses

If you are exporting your horse, please complete the following information.

- Temporary** If temporary, the time limit for your horse in the US is **30 days or less** after the date of inspection by the Canadian Accredited Veterinarian. You can cross the border any day of the week, any time.
- Permanent** If permanent, the time limit for your horse in the US is **31 days or greater** after the date of the inspection by the Canadian Accredited Veterinarian. You must meet a vet at the border with your horse during office hours, Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.
